c) Pending Litigation

Director Frisco reported an update on the current decision from the Court of Common Pleas in the matter of Landers v MCVSC. It has been presented that in spite of the court's decision, MCVSC may be required to remit OPERs contributions and deductions. This is a change from what was previously understood by the commission and staff. Deputy Director Suddith reviewed the budgetary implications of the decision with the Commission advising them that there may be a future need for a resolution to request an additional appropriation from the Board of County Commissioners. Commissioners directed the Executive Director to follow up with legal counsel in this matter for further clarification of the judge's order titled Judgement Entry Denying Request to Correct Trial Decisions dated March 27, 2024.

VII. New Business

a) Commissioner Howley addressed the commission with a Veteran concern about pending GDRTA (Greater Dayton Regional Transit Authority) cost increases and any affect they may have on Veteran transportation. Executive Director Frisco relayed information from the MCVSC Transportation Coordinator about the proposed rate increases that may come in 2026 for the Paratransit program. Current rates for the Uber/RTA Connect services will not see an increase in fees.

b) Personnel Matter

Commissioner Theobald moved to enter executive session for purposes outlined in ORC 121.22 G (1), to discuss Personnel Matters and specifically employee compensation. Commissioner Fried seconded the motion.
