V. Public Comments

Mr. William Bowers addressed the Commission, he recently attended the Atlanta Military Influencer Conference 2024. He praised the commission for how well they respond to the needs of Montgomery County, Ohio.

He also attended the 2024 Ohio Defense & Aerospace Forum at Wright State University.

Mr. Bowers informed the commission of the following upcoming events:

- 1. Wright Patterson AFB will be hosting the 2024 Annual Retiree Appreciation Day on October 23, 2024, from 7 a.m. to 2p.m. It is open to all military retirees and their families.
- 2. The Wright State University Student Veteran Association is holding a Land Navigation Challenge on Saturday, November 2, 2024, open to current students.
- 3. The DAV's 5K event will be held on Saturday, November 9, 2024, at Great American Ball Park, there is still time to register.
- 4. Air Force Sergeants Association Chapter 751 is looking for donations for the

gift baskets. Last year they provided gift cards to 180 active-duty personnel to help with Thanksgiving dinner.

Mr. Fred Rojas, presented on behalf of Freedom Whiskey Veteran's Celebration honoring the 2024 Veteran of the Year Dr. Cassie Barlow. The event will take place on November 16, 2024, from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. at the Miamisburg Moose Lodge. All proceeds from this event will benefit Hunter's Helping Heroes and will also send 3 veterans through the Save a Warrior program. Mr. Rojas requested a sponsorship/partnership from MCVSC. After a lengthy discussion between Mr. Rojas and the Commissioners and after review of the Ohio Attorney General's Opinion (2001 Op. Att'y Gen. No. 2001-033), it was determined that MCVSC is prohibited from sponsoring this nonprofit organization as we are not permitted to have an outreach table/space in order for our Veteran Service Officer(s) to speak to the veterans in attendance. Mr. Rojas requested that the MVSC website and sponsorship form be updated to include the Ohio AG guidelines. Mr. Fried stated that our form has not yet caught up with the current guidelines and that it will be rectified.

Mr. Rojas also requested that any open job posting within MCVSC be shared with the local posts.

a.) Consideration of Soldiers and Sailors Financial Assistance for the period of September 1 - 30, 2024. Commissioner Theobald moved to approve, and Commissioner Dare seconded the motion.

 - There are no eligible candidates yet for the open Legal Counsel position. Mr. Theobald suggested that she also send the job opening to the University of Cincinnati and The Ohio State University Law departments.
 - The Medal of Honor Memorial will be breaking ground in November. The pledge of \$50,000 toward the construction and maintenance will most likely be needed this calendar year.
- b.) Executive Director Frisco also presented the Budget, Outreach, Productivity and Transportation reports.

 - Approximately 220 letters went out for the Aldi Gift Cards and Coat Drive. The coat drive will begin 11/15/2024.
 - A request to help a dying veteran fulfill his last wish of going home and sitting on his porch was received. Staff are currently working out the details with the man's family and transportation providers in hopes of being able to fulfill this wish.

- Commissioner Fried (VVA) Temple Beth Or is hosting "Veterans Healing Wounds," a PTSD awareness event. Mr. Fried will be speaking at this event and requested a slide to be added to his current presentation to include a list of PTSD community resources. He also commends Director Frisco on a job well done with the website and asks that the job postings also be posted on the website as they come available. The VVA will have their next meeting on 10/17/2024. The VA Volunteer Quarterly meeting was held on 9/12/2024 and it was confirmed that the VA is currently open to volunteers, please coordinate any volunteer visits with Tiffany. Mr. Fried encouraged the other commissioners to review the State Association's meeting minutes as they are now available. Commissioner Fried will be on vacation from 10/18/24 through 10/31/2024.
- Commissioner Dare (American Legion) Mr. Dare thanked Kim for helping him get in touch with the Germantown Veterans Memorial Museum, where he was able to donate trunks that contained military memorabilia that had been his family for a number of

years. The American Legion has met their goal of 570 memberships for the year.
